Bluewater Studio, in partnership with the Forest County Potawatomi Community, Lord Cultural Resources, and WeatherstonBruer Associates, developed and installed a 2,700 square foot interpretive exhibit within a unique 12-sided gallery.

Designed to share the stories of the Potawatomi people with both tribal and non-tribal audiences, the exhibit features interactives, media and technology, large-scale graphics, and engaging artifact displays.

Highlights include a fire sculpture honoring the tribe's role as Keepers of the Fire, immersive environments such as a wigwam and canoe, interactive experiences, and an immersive theater space with a "Who We Are" film.

Bluewater Studio led the design-build process, overseeing planning, fabrication, installation, and gallery renovation to create a dynamic, multi-generational experience.
